Job Details

Summary of position:

Ancillary ABE teacher provides instruction to adult students remotely and/or in a hyflex classroom (students may attend in-person or remotely). The focus of instruction is to help students develop skills in writing, reading comprehension and/or math in order to pass High School Equivalency tests (GED). Students who are eligible for the ABE program must be over 18 years of age, residents of Pennsylvania and should have a goal of obtaining or advancing employment and/or entering post-secondary training, once they have completed the GED credential.

Current position openings:

- Evening HSE Prep Teacher: Teaches reading strategies for testing success and provides review of crucial concepts for Social Studies, Science and Language Arts GED tests. Schedule is Tuesday and Thursday, 6 to 9pm.
- Evening HSE Math Teacher (8th to 12 grade level math): Teaches test taking strategies and general review of math content necessary to pass the GED test. Schedule is Mondays and Wednesdays, 6 to 9pm.

Salary:

Ancillary staff are paid for hours worked, which includes time for teacher orientation, instruction, preparation, meetings, and professional development. Current hourly rate is \$29 per hour.
