

# Integrated Education and Training (IET) Overview

IET is a workforce development and career pathways strategy that offers occupational training, adult education, and workforce preparation skills simultaneously, unlike other models that offer these components sequentially.



# Skills adults need are taught simultaneously which allows adults to gain job skills faster.

- Is there a job at the end of the training?
- Is there a viable career path attached to the job?
- Is the job in demand in your region?
- Will you have interested partners?
- Will you have interested learners?
