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May payments

- May payments: 064 and 054 grants
 - Lump sum incentive funds payments in April may have resulted in suspension of May payment
 - If need on-demand payment, email your advisor by May 31 (tomorrow)



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2024-25 continuation grants: amounts

- Adult Basic Education Direct Service 064
 - Federal 064: 3 percent COLA; all grantees
 - State 064: Includes additional funds for direct service staff, if approved
- Section 243 IELCE
 - 3 percent COLA; all grantees
- Family Literacy Direct Service
 - Includes additional funds awarded for 2022-23 performance
 - Includes addition funds for direct service staff, if approved



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2024-25 continuation grants

- Adult Basic Education Direct Service 064
 - Federal 064: local match is 20 percent
 - To calculate, divide grant amount by 4
 - State 064: 1692 minimum
 - 10 percent of 2022-23 grant amount
 - No increase with additional funds
- Section 243 IELCE
 - Local match is 20 percent
 - To calculate, divide grant amount by 4



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2024-25 grants: additional funds for staff

- State 064 and FL 054
 - Specific sections for additional funds for staff
 - Must use those funds only for what division approved
- Option “Add FT teacher w/increased contracted enrollment”
 - Advisor will contact agencies to discuss new enrollment number



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Additional \$ for increased enrollment in 2024-25

- Federal 064; 061
- YTD agency enrollment and EFL gain
 - April 29 data
 - Students only counted in one grant
- 80%+ enrollment AND 35%+ EFL gain



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Additional \$ for increased enrollment: agencies

- 064
 - Intermediate Unit 1
 - Keystone Opportunity Center
 - Lehigh Carbon CC & The Literacy Center
 - Project of Easton
- 061
 - Lehigh Carbon CC
- Eligible to request additional funds for increased enrollment



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Next chance for additional \$ for increased enrollment

- Final 2023-24 enrollment & EFL gain
- Data after eData closes for the PY
- Criteria:
 - Meet or exceed contracted enrollment AND
 - 40% EFL gain OR
 - (for 064 only) 10% improvement in EFL gain from 2022-23
- If meet criteria, will have opportunity to request additional federal funds



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2024-25 grants: eGrants

- FC 2270 Staff Professional Development
 - In State 064, 054, 061, and 259
 - Put all staff time engaging in professional development in 2270
 - Also associate benefits and other costs
- Purchased PD expenses: 2300/360



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Importance of quick grant approval

- Get money sooner
- Get into eData sooner
- Advisor happy
- Your fiscal and data departments happy



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Function codes and object codes

- Look at previous grant/FER to ensure that descriptions match
- Look at guidelines
 - Don't combine items that need to be separate (e.g. travel and conference fees)
- Check carefully
- Check again



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Explanations and descriptions

- Purchased equipment – narrative explanation REQUIRED
- Salary: “Other” actual job duties or title REQUIRED
- Description column
 - Not repeat object code label (e.g. 610 supplies, description supplies)



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Consistency

- Staff names across grants
- Descriptions across grants

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Follow procedures

- Initial submission
 - Submit grant in eGrants
- Returned grants
- Make corrections quickly
 - Read comments in every section
 - Make ALL corrections
 - Check and doublecheck
- Email advisor for review
- Only resubmit once advisor gives ok



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Excel option in eGrants

- Use to
 - Check number of employee hours across grants
 - Check benefits, esp. FICA
 - Check PD and prep time
 - Put PD in one function code (2270) for each employee
- Can combine expenses across grants for thorough review
- Can sort and filter spreadsheets
